We bring to your attention the Accelerated Stream of the MSc in Physics.

This is basically a combined five year BSc-MSc program. In the last year of the BSc, the interested student who must have a minimum GPA of A- chooses a fourth year project that could lead to an MSc thesis and whose supervisor may be willing to support as an MSc student. In the second semester of the project, the student would apply for the accelerated stream of the MSc if he/she has the support of the supervisor. The student also has to identify a 4000 or 5000 level course that will count towards the MSc. That course will have to be completed with at least an A- grade.

Students in the accelerated stream will take two additional courses during their registration as MSc students and are expected to complete all requirements within three sessions, but may take longer.
